4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO HEALTH SCIENCE DEGREE COURSES

4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National. However Non Resident Indian (NRI) will be eligible only on All India basis in private unaided colleges under NRI Quota.

4.1.1 Indian Citizen

4.1.2 Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Candidate will be eligible for Government / Corporation / Government Aided / Private unaided college for academic year 2019-20 only. Provided such candidate have passed 10th & 12th from the State of Maharashtra and should be domicile of Maharashtra or staying in state of Maharashtra for minimum period of 10 years. (As per Annexure – M)

4.1.3 NRI candidate will be eligible for institutional quota seat only, NRI Candidate will not be eligible for other seat. (As per Annexure – Y).

4.2 Domicile of Candidate: - The Candidates must be Domicile of Maharashtra (Except candidates under clause 4.1.3, 4.7, 4.8, Annexure C and E).

4.3 The candidate must be born on or before 31st December 2002 to be eligible for all Health Science Courses. The Birth certificate indicating name of the candidate, Secondary School Certificate i.e. SSC or equivalent examination certificate or School Leaving Certificate endorsing the date of birth will constitute a valid proof.

4.3.1 Upper age limit for Admission to B.A.M.S., B.U.M.S and B.H.M.S degree Course – Not more than twenty-five years on or before 31st December of the year of admission in the first year of the course. Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed by five years in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward classes and Physically Handicapped candidates.

4.4 The candidate must be medically fit and must submit a certificate of medical fitness at the time of Document Verification as per proforma. (Annexure-"H")

4.5 The candidate must have passed the SSC or equivalent examination from an Institution situated in the state of Maharashtra. (Please refer 4.1.3, 4.7, 4.8, Annexure "C" & Annexure "E" for exception)

Exemption – Candidate who has passed SSC or equivalent examination in 2017 or prior to that, from an institute outside the State of Maharashtra is also eligible to seek admission in this Category, provided he has passed HSC or qualifying

examination from an institute in the State of Maharashtra and also possess Domicile Certificate issued by the authority, who is competent to issue such certificate in the State of Maharashtra for educational purpose gazette no. MED-1018/C.R. 405/18/Edu-2 dated 20/04/2019.

- 4.6 The candidate must have passed the qualifying examination i.e. Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC/12th Standard) or equivalent examination, from an Institution situated in the State of Maharashtra (Please refer 4.1.3, 4.7, 4.8, Annexure "C" & Annexure "E" for exception) **with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) at the time of document verification.**

4.6.1 Eligibility criteria of Qualifying Examination for various courses

- 4.6.1.1 For MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BUMS/BHMS: A candidate belonging to Open Category must have obtained not less than 50% (i.e. 150 out of 300) marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together at the HSC (or equivalent) Examination. A candidate belonging to constitutional reservation (Annexure- B); and constitutional reservation with Person with disability claim must have obtained not less than 40% (i.e. 120 out of 300) marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together at the HSC (or equivalent) Examination. Person with disability candidate in General category must secure not less than 45% marks (i.e. 135 out of 300) in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together at the HSC (or equivalent) Examination or decided by respective central council.
- 4.6.1.2 For B.Sc. Nursing - A candidate should have passed in the subjects of PCB and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualified examination i.e. (10 + 2). Furthermore, the candidates belonging to SC / ST or other backward classes, the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 45% as stated above. English is a compulsory subject in 10 + 2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc(N) OR as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council from time to time.
- 4.6.1.3 For BPTH, BOTH, BASLP & BP & O courses: Clause 4.6.1.1 is not applicable. Passing grade at HSC/12th Standard or equivalent examination is however necessary.

4.6.1.4 For admission to BP&O candidates who have passed 12th standard examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and / or Mathematics are eligible.

4.6.1.5 For admission to BASLP, candidates who have passed 12th standard examination with Physics, Biology, Chemistry and/or Mathematics and/or Computer Science are eligible.

4.7 Exception for SSC (10th) and HSC (12th) or equivalent examinations: Children of employees of the Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking:-

Children of employees of the Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking posted on deputation or transfer to a place outside the State of Maharashtra; or transferred from outside to a place situated within the State of Maharashtra:-

4.7.1 The children of such employees of Government of Maharashtra or its undertaking who have joined service since beginning at a place situated outside the State of Maharashtra but who have been transferred to a place situated within the State of Maharashtra shall be eligible for admission even though such children might have passed the S.S.C.(Std. X) and/or H.S.C. (Std.XII) or equivalent exam from the recognized institutions situated outside the State of Maharashtra, provided that such an employee of Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking must have been transferred/ deputed at a place of work located in the State of Maharashtra and also must have reported-for-duty i.e. joined the duty before the last date of document verification.

4.7.2 The candidates belonging to the aforesaid category at (1) shall be required to produce the requisite Certificate from the Office at which such an employee of Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking has reported for duty as a proof that such employee has joined the office and/or reported for duty before the cutoff date for eligibility i.e. the last date of submission of Preference Form. The certificate should contain full name of the employee, designation, transfer order number and date, date of joining and present status of posting. A copy of transfer order should also be produced at the time of document verification.

4.7.3 The children of such employees of Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking who have been transferred or deputed to a place situated

outside the State of Maharashtra or who have returned to the State of Maharashtra after initial transfer/deputation shall be eligible for admission even though such children might have passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) and/or H.S.C. (Std. XII) or equivalent examinations from the recognized Institutions situated outside the State of Maharashtra.

4.7.4 The candidates belonging to the aforesaid category at (3) above shall be required to produce the requisite Certificate from the Office at which such an employee of Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking has reported for duty. The certificate should contain full name of the employee, designation, transfer order number and date, date of joining and present status of posting. A copy of transfer order should also be produced at the time of document verification.

4.8 Exception for SSC (10th) and HSC (12th) or equivalent examinations: Children of employees of Government of India or its Undertaking:-

4.8.1 The children of the employees of Government of India or its Undertaking shall be eligible for admission even though they might have passed the S.S.C. (Std.X) and/or H.S.C. (Std. XII) or equivalent exam from the recognized Institutions situated outside the State of Maharashtra, provided that such an employee of Government of India or its Undertaking must have been transferred from outside State of Maharashtra at a place of work, located in the State of Maharashtra and also must have reported for duty and must be working as on the last date of Document verification at a place located in State of Maharashtra.

4.8.2 The candidates belonging to the aforesaid category (1) shall be required to produce the requisite Certificate from the Office at which such an employee of Government of India or its Undertaking has reported for duty as a proof of the fact that such employee has joined the office and/or reported for duty before the cutoff date for eligibility i.e., the last date of submission of document verification. The certificate should contain full name of the employee, designation, transfer order number and date, date of joining and present status of posting. A copy of transfer order should also be produced at the time of document verification.

4.9 NEET UG 2019 Eligibility for Admission to MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BUMS and BHMS Courses: A candidate belonging to open category must secure not less than 50

percentile marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together at NEET UG-2019. A candidate belonging to constitutional reservation (Annexure B); and constitutional reservation with Person with disability claim must secure not less than 40 percentile marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together in the NEET UG -2019. Person with disability candidate in General category must secure not less than 45 percentile marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together in the NEET UG -2019 or decided by respective central council time to time.

- 4.10 NEET UG-2019 Marks for Admission to BPTth/BOTH /BASLP /BP&O and B.Sc. Nursing: A candidate will be selected on the basis of merit in NEET UG -2019 to above stated courses.
- 4.11 **Additional Eligibility for BUMS:** Candidate should have passed SSC (or equivalent) examination from the recognized board with *Urdu or Arabic or Persian Language* as one of the subject.
- 4.12 **Cut-off date for the eligibility:** The eligibility of the candidate shall be determined and/or decided for all purposes including for applicability of all these Rules and Regulations by considering the last date of physical document verification as the cut off date. It is made abundantly clear that if a candidate is found ineligible as on the last date of submission of physical document verification, in terms of these Rules and Regulations, and if such an ineligible candidate acquires the requisite eligibility after the aforesaid cutoff date (i.e. the last date of Physical Document Verification), such subsequent acquisition of eligibility will not make an ineligible candidate eligible for any purpose whatsoever, much less for the purpose of admission.
- 4.13 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Defence (specified) reservation in Government/Corporation/Government Aided Colleges Only: Refer Annexure - C.
- 4.14 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Person with Disability (specified) reservation in Government / Corporation / Government Aided Colleges only - Refer Annexure - D.
- 4.15 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Maharashtra Karnataka Border (MKB) area (specified) reservation in Government / Corporation / Government Aided Colleges Only - Refer Annexure - E.
- 4.16 Hilly Area seat claim in Government / Corporation, MBBS Colleges Only - Refer to conditions/criteria under Annexure-F.

- o. "National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test" or "NEET" means the examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi for admission to under graduate Medical and Dental Courses.
- p. "Non-Resident Indian (NRI)" means a person who is "not ordinarily resident" under sub-section (6) of section 6 of the Income Tax Act, 1961, and includes a person resident outside India under clause (w) of section 2 of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, and also includes his child or ward;
- q. "Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)" means a candidate or a person registered as an Overseas Citizen of India as declared by the Central Government under section 7A of the Citizenship Act 1955, and includes Persons of Indian Origin (PIO).
Explanation.—For the purposes of this clause, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) card-holders registered under Notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Home-Affairs No. F.No. 26011/04/98- F. I, dated 19th August 2002 and shall now be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India, (OCI) cardholders by virtue of Notification of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, No. 25024/9/2014-F.I, dated 9th January 2015.
- r. "Qualifying Examination" means the Higher Secondary Certificate (12th Standard) or equivalent examination, from an institution situated in the State of Maharashtra with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany and Zoology) at the time of admission;
- s. "Region" means the area in respective Statutory Development Board for Vidarbha, Marathwada and Rest of Maharashtra;
- t. "SSC" means the Secondary School Certificate (Standard X) examination conducted by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education as per the provisions of the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965) or its equivalent certificate awarded by a recognised Board;

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO HEALTH SCIENCE DEGREE COURSES

- 4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National. However Non Resident Indian (NRI) will be eligible only on all India basis in private unaided college in NRI Quota.

4.1.1 Indian Citizen

4.1.2 Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Candidate will be eligible for Government / Corporation / Government Aided / Private unaided college for academic year 2018-19 and 2019-20 only. Provided such candidate have passed 10th & 12th from the State of Maharashtra and should be domicile of Maharashtra or staying in state of Maharashtra for minimum period of 10 years. (As per Annexure – M)

4.1.3 NRI candidate will be eligible for institutional quota seat only, NRI Candidate will not be eligible for other seat. (As per Annexure – U).

- 4.2 Domicile of Candidate:** - The Candidates must be Domicile of Maharashtra (Except candidates under clause 4.1.3, 4.7, 4.8, Annexure C and E).
- 4.3** The candidate must be born on or before 31st December 2001 to be eligible for all the courses except Ayurved and Unani courses. However, for admission to Ayurved and Unani courses, candidate must be born on or before 1st October 2001. The Birth certificate indicating name of the candidate, Secondary School Certificate i.e. SSC or equivalent examination certificate or School Leaving Certificate endorsing the date of birth will constitute a valid proof.
- 4.4** The candidate must be medically fit and must submit a certificate of medical fitness at the time of Document Verification as per proforma. (Annexure-"H")
- 4.5** The candidate must have passed the SSC or equivalent examination from an Institution situated in the state of Maharashtra. (Please refer 4.7, 4.8, Annexure "C" & Annexure "E" for exception)
- 4.6** The candidate must have passed the qualifying examination i.e. Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC/12th Standard) or equivalent examination, from an Institution situated in the State of Maharashtra (Please refer 4.7, 4.8, Annexure"C" & Annexure "E" for exception) with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) at the time of document verification.

- 4.11 **Additional Eligibility for BUMS:** Candidate should have passed SSC (or equivalent) examination from the recognized board with *Urdu or Arabic or Persian Language* as one of the subject.
- 4.12 **Cut-off date for the eligibility:** The eligibility of the candidate shall be determined and/or decided for all purposes including for applicability of all these Rules and Regulations by considering the last date of document verification as the cut off date. XII) or equivalent examination/s from an Institution/s situated outside the State of Maharashtra and not Domicile of Maharashtra are not ELIGIBLE for admission to Health Science courses except, those exempted under Rule 4.7, 4.8, Defence & MKB and NRI quota (41.2) in private unaided college.
- 4.18 Admission to Health Science Courses is subject to the grant of eligibility by Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik.

- a) From among the candidates of the same category by inter-se State merit. If the seats still remain vacant, then the seats will be filled,
 - b) From among the candidates of their respective group of that particular Regional area where the vacancies exist, by inter-se Regional Area merit. The groups are as follows :
 - c) i) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism (S.C)
 - ii) Scheduled Tribes (S.T)
 - d) i) Vimukta Jati - DT-A (V.J)
 - ii) Nomadic Tribes - NT-B (N.T-1)
 - e) i) Nomadic Tribes - NT-C (N.T-2)
 - ii) Nomadic Tribes - NT-D (N.T-3)
 - iii) Other Backward Classes (including SBC) (O.B.C)
- If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
- f) From among the candidates of all categories mentioned above of that particular Regional Area where the vacancies exist, by inter-se Regional Area merit. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
 - g) From among the candidates of the common merit list of the concerned Regional Area. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
 - h) From among the candidates of the common merit list of the inter-se state merit.

9.1.5.2 Children of Defence personnel (DEF): (Refer Annx.-C)

The seats reserved for Defence category candidates will be filled regionwise. In the event of non-availability of candidate in any of the defence category, the vacancies that have remained unfilled will be filled by inter-se merit of the candidates from remaining two defence categories of the same region. Even after this, if the seats remain vacant, then they will be filled in from 70% open category as these defence seats have been carved out from 70% open category. Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection.

9.1.5.3 Person with Disability (PWD) Quota: As per Government letter No. MED-1006/CR-72/06/Edu-2, dated 07/03/2006, Three (3%) percent of the total available seats in Health Science Courses at Government, Corporation and Govt. Aided colleges are reserved for Person with disability candidates.

1) As per Graduate Medical Education Regulation 1997 and Amendment Notification No. MCI-34(41)/2008-Med./54469 Dated 25th March 2009, and MCI guidelines letter No.MCI-34(1)/2003-Med/11773, dated 14/07/2003 following is the criteria for reservation under PWD Category

3% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%.

admission to Ayurved, Homeopathy and Unani courses, candidate must be born on or before 1st October 2000. The Birth certificate indicating name of the candidate, Secondary School Certificate i.e. SSC or equivalent examination certificate or School Leaving Certificate endorsing the date of birth will constitute a valid proof.

- 4.4 The candidate must be medically fit and must submit a certificate of medical fitness at the time of Document Verification as per proforma. (Annexure-"H")
- 4.5 The candidate must have passed the SSC or equivalent examination from an Institution situated in the state of Maharashtra. (Please refer 4.7, 4.8, Annexure "C" & Annexure "E" for exception)
- 4.6 The candidate must have passed the qualifying examination i.e. Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC/12th Standard) or equivalent examination, from an Institution situated in the State of Maharashtra (Please refer 4.7, 4.8, Annexure "C" & Annexure "E" for exception) with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) at the time of admission.

4.6.1 Eligibility criteria of Qualifying Examination for various courses

4.6.1.1 For MBBS/BDS/BAMS : A candidate belonging to Open Category must have obtained not less than 50% (i.e. 150 out of 300) marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together at the HSC (or equivalent) Examination. A candidate belonging to constitutional reservation (Annex. B); and constitutional reservation with Person with disability claim must have obtained not less than 40% (i.e. 120 out of 300) marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together at the HSC (or equivalent) Examination. Person with disability candidate in General category must secure not less than 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together at the HSC (or equivalent) Examination.

4.6.1.2 For BSc. Nursing - A candidate should have passed in the subjects of PCB and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualified examination i.e (10+2). Furthermore, the candidates belonging to constitution reservation, the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 45% as stated above. English is a compulsory subject in 10 + 2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc (N) OR as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council from time to time.

- o. "National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test" or "NEET" means the examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi for admission to under graduate Medical and Dental Courses.
- p. "Non-Resident Indian (NRI)" means a person who is "not ordinarily resident" under sub-section (6) of section 6 of the Income Tax Act, 1961, and includes a person resident outside India under clause (w) of section 2 of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, and also includes his child or ward;
- q. "Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)" means a candidate or a person registered as an Overseas Citizen of India as declared by the Central Government under section 7A of the Citizenship Act 1955, and includes Persons of Indian Origin (PIO).
Explanation.—For the purposes of this clause, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) card-holders registered under Notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs No. F.No. 26011/04/98- F. I, dated 19th August 2002 and shall now be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India, (OCI) cardholders by virtue of Notification of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, No. 25024/9/2014-F.I, dated 9th January 2015.
- r. "Qualifying Examination" means the Higher Secondary Certificate (12th Standard) or equivalent examination, from an institution situated in the State of Maharashtra with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany and Zoology) at the time of admission;
- s. "Region" means the area in respective Statutory Development Board for Vidarbha, Marathwada and Rest of Maharashtra;
- t. "SSC" means the Secondary School Certificate (Standard X) examination conducted by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education as per the provisions of the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965) or its equivalent certificate awarded by a recognised Board;

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO HEALTH SCIENCE DEGREE COURSES

- 4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National. However Non Resident Indian (NRI) will be eligible only under institutional quota seats(including NRI Quota).
- 4.1.1 Indian Citizen
- 4.1.2 NRI candidate will be eligible for institutional quota seat only, NRI Candidate will not be eligible for other seat.
- 4.1.3 OCI / PIO eligible
- 4.2 Domicile of Candidate: - The Candidates must be Domicile of Maharashtra (Except candidates under clause 4.1.3, 4.7, 4.8, Annexure C and E).
- 4.3 The candidate must be born on or before 31st December 2000 to be eligible for all the courses except Ayurved, Homeopathy and Unani courses. However, for

- j. "Institutional Quota" means seats available for admission to eligible Candidates at Institution level as declared by the Government or appropriate authority from time to time;
- k. "*inter-se-merit*" means the order of merit in respect of various classes or category of Candidates;
- l. "Minority Quota" means seats earmarked for the Minority Community students from within the State of Maharashtra, belonging to the Minority Community to which the institution belongs;
- m. "MUHS" means the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences established under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act, 1998 (Mah. X of 1999);
- n. "MCI" means the Medical Council of India constituted under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956);

- 4.7.3 The children of such employees of Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking who have been transferred or deputed to a place situated outside the State of Maharashtra or who have returned to the State of Maharashtra after initial transfer/deputation shall be eligible for admission even though such children might have passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) and/or H.S.C. (Std. XII) or equivalent examinations from the recognized Institutions situated outside the State of Maharashtra.
- 4.7.4 The candidates belonging to the aforesaid category at (3) above shall be required to produce the requisite Certificate from the Office at which such an employee of Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking has reported for duty. The certificate should contain full name of the employee, designation, transfer order number and date, date of joining and present status of posting. A copy of transfer order should also be produced at the time of document verification.
- 4.8 Exception for SSC (10th) and HSC (12th) or equivalent examinations: Children of employees of Government of India or its Undertaking:-**
- 4.8.1 The children of the employees of Government of India or its Undertaking shall be eligible for admission even though they might have passed the S.S.C. (Std.X) and/or H.S.C. (Std. XII) or equivalent exam from the recognized Institutions situated outside the State of Maharashtra, provided that such an employee of Government of India or its Undertaking must have been transferred from outside State of Maharashtra at a place of work, located in the State of Maharashtra and also must have reported for duty and must be working as on the last date of Document verification at a place located in State of Maharashtra.
- 4.8.2 The candidates belonging to the aforesaid category (1) shall be required to produce the requisite Certificate from the Office at which such an employee of Government of India or its Undertaking has reported for duty as a proof of the fact that such employee has joined the office and/or reported for duty before the cutoff date for eligibility i.e., the last date of submission of document verification. The certificate should contain full name of the employee, designation, transfer order number and date, date of joining and present status of posting. A copy of transfer order should also be produced at the time of document verification.

- 4.6.1.3 For BHMS, BUMS, BPT_h, BOT_h, BASLP & BP&O courses: Clause 4.6.1.1 is not applicable. Passing grade at HSC/12th Standard or equivalent examination is however necessary.
- 4.6.1.4 For admission to BP&O candidates who have passed 12th standard examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and / or Mathematics are eligible.
- 4.6.1.5 For admission to BASLP, candidates who have passed 12th standard examination with Physics, Biology, Chemistry and/or Mathematics and/or Computer Science are eligible.
- 4.7 Exception for SSC (10th) and HSC (12th) or equivalent examinations: Children of employees of the Government of Maharashtra or its Undertaking:-

- 4.9 NEET UG 2017 Eligibility for Admission to MBBS & BDS Courses: A candidate belonging to open category must secure not less than 50 percentile marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together at NEET UG-2017. A candidate belonging to constitutional reservation (Annexure B); and constitutional reservation with Person with disability claim must secure not less than 40 percentile marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together in the NEET UG - 2017. Person with disability candidate in General category must secure not less than 45 percentile marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together in the NEET UG -2017.
- 4.10 NEET UG-2017 Marks for Admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS/BPTh/BOTH /BASLP /BP&O and B.Sc. Nursing: A candidate will be selected on the basis of merit in NEET UG -2017 to above stated courses.
- 4.11 **Additional Eligibility for BUMS:** Candidate should have passed SSC (or equivalent) examination from the recognized board with *Urdu or Arabic or Persian Language* as one of the subject.
- 4.12 **Cut-off date for the eligibility:** The eligibility of the candidate shall be determined and/or decided for all purposes including for applicability of all these Rules and Regulations by considering the last date of document verification as the cut off date. It is made abundantly clear that if a candidate is found ineligible as on the last date of submission of document verification, in terms of these Rules and Regulations, and if such an ineligible candidate acquires the requisite eligibility after the aforesaid cutoff date (i.e. the last date of Document Verification), such subsequent acquisition of eligibility will not make an ineligible candidate eligible for any purpose whatsoever, much less for the purpose of admission.

- 4.14 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Person with disability (specified) reservation in Government / Corporation / Government Aided Colleges only - Refer Annexure - D.
- 4.15 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Maharashtra Karnataka Border (MKB) area (specified) reservation in Government / Corporation / Government Aided Colleges Only - Refer Annexure - E.
- 4.16 Hilly Area seat claim in Government / Corporation, MBBS Colleges Only - Refer to conditions/criteria under Annexure-F.
- 4.17 All those candidates who have passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) and/or H.S.C. (Std. XII) or equivalent examination/s from an Institution/s situated outside the State of Maharashtra and not Domicile of Maharashtra are not ELIGIBLE for admission to Health Science courses except, those exempted under Rule 4.7, 4.8, Defence & MKB and NRI quota (4.1.2) in private unaided college.

4.18 Admission to Health Science Courses is subject to the grant of eligibility by Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik.

8. *Allocation of seats*.—The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates through NEET for First Year of the Courses shall be as per the MCI and DCI regulations, and in accordance with the policy of the Government as specified in the Schedule.—

(1) *Maharashtra State Candidature Seats*.—The Candidates having Maharashtra State Candidature as specified in sub-rule (1) of rule 5, shall be eligible for these seats.

(2) *Minority Candidature Seats*.—The Candidates having Candidature mentioned in sub-rule (2) of rule 5 shall be eligible for these seats as specified in the Schedule. These seats shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 6 of the Act.

(3) *Institutional Quota Seats* - The Institution can admit Eligible Candidates against 15 percent of the Sanctioned Intake, as per the Schedule, subject to following conditions, namely:—

The Secondary School Certificate (i.e. SSC) or equivalent examination certificate endorsing the date of birth will constitute the valid proof.
- 6.3 The candidate must be medically fit and must submit a certificate of medical fitness Annexure "G".
- 6.4 Eligibility Criteria for qualifying Examination for various courses:-

6.4.1 For MBBS, BDS and BAMS:-

A candidate belonging to open category must have obtained not less than 50% Marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology subject taken together at the XIIStd / HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.

A Candidates belonging to Reserved Category must have obtained not less than 40% Marks Physics, Chemistry & Biology subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.

6.4.2 For B. Sc (Nursing):-

A candidate belonging to open category must have obtained not less than 45% Marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.

A Candidates belonging to Reserved Category must have obtained not less than 40% Marks Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.

6.4.3 For BPT, BOT, BASLP rule no. 6.4.1, 6.4.2 and 6.4.3 is not applicable to this course, passing at Std. XII or HSC or equivalent examination is necessary.

6.5 No rounding off of the marks secured by the candidate will be done in individual subject or final total while converting marks of the individual subject out of 100 or total marks out of 300. For example, if the total of the marks in three subjects comes to 149 out of 300, percentage comes to 49.66 that will not qualify the candidate.

6.6 The candidates who are appearing for the qualifying examination i.e. HSC or equivalent in March/April-2014 are also eligible to appear for Asso-CET 2014, provided they must fulfill the eligibility criteria.

6.7 The eligibility conditions may vary in accordance with Judicial Pronouncements and orders issued by appropriate Authorities from time to time.

7. REVALUATION OF HSC / EQUIVALENT MARKS

If the marks of a candidate at HSC (or equivalent) examination have been revised after re-evaluation, the eligibility of the candidate may be altered. The candidate will be permitted to avail the benefit of revised marks subject to his/her representation to the Competent Authority and production of necessary proof to the satisfaction of the Competent Authority. The candidates must note that the Competent Authority will not be responsible for late declaration of result of such re-evaluations or late submissions of proof due to any reason whatsoever and request to consider / reconsider the claim of the candidate arising out of such re-evaluation shall not be entertained.

8. RESERVATIONS

Admissions under the constitutional reservation seats will be governed by the Maharashtra Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Depotified Tribes, (Vimukt Jati), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Category (regulation of issuance and verification of) Caste Certificate Act 2000 (Maharashtra Act No. XXIII of 2001). In this connection Govt. of Maharashtra has issued following notification Annexure "B".

Reservation of Seats for SC/ST/OBC/VJ/NT1/NT2/NT3 will be as per Government notification No MED/2006/1196/CR206/06 Edu-1(2) dated 24/06/2006. Candidate belonging to Reserved Category will be required to submit the caste certificate and the caste/tribe validity certificate from the appropriate authorities of the Government of Maharashtra.

Candidate who wants to claim the benefit of constitutional reservation has to make such a claim in the original application form for Asso CET, later requests will not be considered as per Hon'ble High Court Orders.

NON CREAMY LAYER : A candidate claiming the benefit of reservation under categories applicable will be required to produce Non - Creamy layer Certificate valid upto 31-03-2014. The candidate belonging to Creamy layer must note that the Provision of reservation is Not applicable to them. 31/03/2015 ✓

9. MARKSHEET

- 9.1. The candidate will receive the mark sheet by speed post within two weeks from declaration of final result.
- 9.2. The mark sheets will contain details regarding marks obtained by the candidate and their merit ranking.
- 9.3. **Duplicate Mark Sheet:** In case of loss of original Asso-CET 2014 Mark Sheet, a duplicate Mark Sheet can be obtained on making an application on plain paper to the Competent Authority, AMUPMDC along with a DD of Rs. 1000/- in favour of "AMUPMDC" and payable at "Mumbai".

10. VERIFICATION OF MARKS

The answer sheets of Asso-CET 2014 examination will be assessed by scanning with the help of computer. If the candidate wishes to verify the Answer sheet a written representation in prescribed Proforma (Annexure C) should be submitted to the Competent Authority within 08 days from declaration of results along-with DD of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of "AMUPMDC" and payable at Mumbai. The candidate will be given photocopy of the answer sheet and model answer key after verification by the Competent Authority. In case, there is any change in the marks in verification, revised mark-sheet will be issued.

Marks obtained by the candidate at the Asso-CET 2014 will form the basis of selection.
