Special Programs for Slow Learners

1. **Orientation Program:** Immediately after admission, we conduct Orientation program in which Dean interacts with parents and students. In this program, parents and students are made aware about rules & regulations, different Committees/ Cells with the role of each committee, the different programs conducted in our college. The orientation is also conducted for 2nd, 3rd and final year students at the start of the session.
2. **Normal treatment:** We treat slow learners as normal students and avoid labeling them as slow learners as it can affect their performance. Also it may lead to stress and further lack of interest in their studies.
3. **Remedial Coaching:** The list of slow learners is circulated to the respective subject teachers so that a special attention is given to these students and if needed extra classes are conducted
4. **Internal Assessment Tests:** As per the university guidelines, three Internal Assessment tests are conducted per year, the record of which has to be sent to the University. So the performance of the students is monitored periodically.
5. **Parent Teacher Meeting:** Two Parent Teacher meetings are conducted in which the performance and attendance of the students is discussed with their parents. Also the parents are free to come and meet the subject teacher anytime to discuss about their child.
6. **Monitoring the attendance and performance of slow learners:** We have a **UG Cell** which monitors the attendance and performance of the students regularly. And it is communicated to the parents too.
7. **Mentoring the slow learners:** We have a fully functioning **Mentorship Cell**. To one mentor, 20 students are allotted. Mentor-Mentee meetings are conducted thrice a year in which the academic related and personal problems are discussed and taken care off. The mentees are free to contact their respective mentors whenever required. The mentors provide special attention to slow learners.
8. **Counseling:** Counseling by professional counselor is provided. After evaluating the problem, if required, students are referred to the psychiatrist available in NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences which is a sister concern of our college.
9. **Training Programs:** Various programs on personality development are conducted which motivates the students.
10. **Revision Classes:** The faculty members revise the tough topics as per the student's requirement. The frequently asked questions are provided to the students. Also the way of writing the answer in the exam is discussed.

Special Programs for Advanced Learners

In addition to above mentioned programs, the following programs are conducted for Advanced Learners.

1. Advanced learners are motivated to achieve higher goals.
2. Also they are motivated to take up small research projects to instill the research orientation.
3. The toppers in the University as well as Internal Assessment Tests are recognized and appreciated. The lists are displayed on the Notice Boards.
4. These students are included in Students Welfare Association of our college and encouraged for organizing various events.
5. Opportunities are provided to develop their creativity by making them participate in various scientific events at college level, state level and national level conferences. Also they are guided for these projects.
6. They are involved in mentorship program to help the average and slow learners.

Slow Learners

Slow learners are the students who learn the necessary academic skills at a rate and depth below that of other students. They progress through the curriculum at a slightly slower rate and may struggle to keep up with concepts, despite working hard. Slow learners typically have difficulty learning new academic material, difficulty in retention and reproduction.

Because of this, they may lag behind and may fail or score poor grades in the exam. Also the attendance is affected. It does not mean, they have poor IQ but it may be due to unsuitable teaching methods, low motivation, improper learning practices or language problem.

Advanced Learners

Advanced learners are the students who learn at a rate that exceeds that of their peers in one or more content areas. The learning of these children falls outside the need-spectrum of the majority of their peers. They have the potential with their comprehension, retention, memory, critical thinking and creativity. They can bring some new concepts, strategies, and also can take the leadership in the teaching learning activities. Because of this, they score high in academics and also achieve high in their life.

Methodology and Criteria for the assessment of learning levels

VSPM Dental College started identifying Slow and Advanced Learners from the 1st year batch of 2015-16.

1st BDS-As the students enters the college, slow and Advanced Learners are identified on the basis of Standard Progressive Matrices (SPM) Test.

SPM is a group or individually administered test that nonverbally assesses intelligence through abstract reasoning tasks. Appropriate for ages 8-65, the SPM consists of 60 problems (five sets of 12), all of which involve completing a pattern or figure with a part missing by choosing the correct missing piece from among six alternatives. Patterns are arranged in order of increasing difficulty. The test is untimed but generally takes 15-45 minutes and results in a raw score which is then converted to a percentile ranking.

Scoring

As per the scoring manual of Standard Progressive Matrices test, following are the percentile as per the obtained scores

Percentile points	Obtained scores
95	55
90	54
75	49

5	25

As per the percentiles, following are the five grades

- Grade I Intellectually Superior 95 percentile
- Grade II Intellectually above average between 75 – 90 percentile
- Grade III Intellectually average between 25-75 percentile
- Grade IV Intellectually below average at or below 25 percentile
- Grade V Intellectually defective at or below 5 percentile

The median of intellectually average group is 50 or less percentile. So as per the norms, obtained score less than 44 is treated as below average or slow learners.

And the obtained score more than 54 is treated as intellectually superior or advanced learners.

Intellectually Average will be between the scores 45-53

2nd BDS, 3rd BDS, 4th BDS- 2nd BDS onwards, the slow and advanced Learners are identified on the basis of their university marks of previous year.

The average of marks of each batch is calculated. After calculating Standard Deviation, the learners scoring below it are considered as slow learners and the learners scoring above it are considered as advanced Learners.
