It was informed that Item No.1 & 2 pertaining to the confirmation of the minutes of the Last meeting of the Academic Council held on 25th Feb. 2015 and the Action Report on the Actionable points arising out of the Minutes were confirmed in the meeting held on 29th June, 2015,. hence in continuation the following items as per the agenda were discussed :

Item No.3 :

To confirm the minutes of the last adjourned meeting of the Academic Council held on Monday, the 29th June, 2015.

The draft Minutes of the adjourned meeting of the Academic Council held on 29th June, 2015 was circulated to all the members requesting them to suggest modification(s) /correction(s) if any required. Since no corrections in the draft minutes were suggested by any of the members, the minutes of the meeting were read out and confirmed unanimously.

Item No.4 :

To Re-consider the recommendations of the Academic Council pertaining to Establishment of the University Department of Biotechnology under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health Sciences, with one full time faculty member so as to start a unique post graduate programme in Entrepreneurial Biotechnology a in phasic manner as referred by the Board of Management.

The Registrar informed that the recommendations of the Academic Council made in its meeting held on 25th Feb. 2015 pertaining to establishment of the **University Department of Biotechnology** under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health Sciences, with one full time faculty member so as to start a unique post graduate programme in **Entrepreneurial Biotechnology** in a phasic manner was placed before the Board of Management in its meeting held on 30th March, 2015 for the consideration. The Board of Management opined that Bio-Technology under the Faculty of interdisciplinary Health Sciences would not be a valid combination. Bio-technology is a stream by itself and without the permission of the UGC or Ministry of HRD, the University cannot start an independent Bio-technology Deptt. under its ambit. It further suggested that instead of establishing a University Deptt. of Bio-technology under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health sciences; a '**University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Medicine**' may be established and the matter was referred back to the Academic Council for re-consideration.

A background note towards establishment of University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Medicine in a phasic manner alongwith the financial prepositions as prepared by Dr. Sandeep Shrivastava, Dean, JNMC on the advice of the Board of Management was placed before the Academic Council for consideration.

The matter was discussed at length. The observations given by BoM were well received by the Academic Council and the proposal in the new format was appreciated by the Academic Council.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the observations of the Board of Management and the background note towards the establishment of the new deptt. appended thereto. It further suggested that the word 'Medicine' be replaced with 'Health Sciences' whereby the nomenclature shall be University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Health Sciences.

The Academic Council authorized Dr. Sandeep Shrivastava, Dean, JNMC to evolve the administrative, academic and financial feasibility of the entire plan including its phases for the consideration of the Finance Committee and Board of Management for consideration and approval.

It was further resolved that the first phase of establishment of the University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Health Sciences must be completed by the end of the academic year 2017-18 i.e. end of five years Perspective Development Plan period 2012-13 – 2017-18.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.5 :

To consider the recommendation of the Board of Examinations made in its emergent meeting held on meeting held 4th April, 2015 –

- 1) Pertaining to addition of a fourth column to the effect 'accepted with corrections', so as to accommodate the modality, which is in operation but has not been indicated in the proforma.**
- 2) The forth column would also bring to fore the column pertaining to 'to be resubmitted after suggestion' would mean that the same would be required to be taken up for evaluation at the subsequent examination of the University.**
- 3) The incorporation of aforesaid guidelines in the governing the evaluation of thesis.**
- 4) The Special Examination Committee should be more vigilant in the dispensation of the required counts at their disposal by a greater degree of vigilance scrutiny blended with care and caution.**
- 5) The recommendations brought out by the Special Examination Committee on any such count should be looked into by the 'Standing Adhoc Committee' of the University in a time bound frame to be made known to all concerned.**

It was informed that in view of the casual taking of the concluding columns by the Internal Valuers and to tide over the situation as of now, the Board of Examination for the purposes of Academic up-gradations made the above recommendations.

The Academic Council unanimously adopted the recommendations of the Board of Examinations. It further directed that these recommendations may be blended with the thesis guidelines and thesis evaluation guidelines to be made known to all concerned right from the beginning and also made known to all concerned and also be included at the PGOOC every year.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.6 :

To note the recommendations of the Planning & Monitoring Board meeting held on 30th March, 2015

The suggestions and recommendations of the Planning & Monitoring Board meeting held on 30th March, 2015 were placed before the Academic Council. The Academic Council went through the suggestions and recommendations point wise. After discussion at length it was unanimously decided that –

1. The Centre for Health Sciences Education Policy & Planning, School for Health Professionals Education & Research and School of Advanced Studies which are the stand alone, functional units and not having the status of constituent unit be declared and notified as the Centre of Excellence initially.
2. To augment the percentage of total no. of interdisciplinary combinations introduced vis a vis total programme to the extent of 25%,
3. To issue guidelines for preparation of proceedings and outcome of international Conferences to ascertain the Quality Status of the International Conference.
4. The proposal for the establishment of a super speciality ancillary hospital by the parent trust which would be outside the purview of the university/teaching hospital and the corpus generated thereof should be utilized as compensatory revenue towards the long term cost sustainability/ developmental pursuits of the teaching hospital/university was accepted in principle. The super speciality connotation in the existing teaching hospital shall be over and above in the appropriate time
5. To set up multiple satellite linkages for education/telemedicine services, health professionals education and capacity building, Interaction/sharing of information from medical colleges towards short term training, specialized lectures from renowned medical college/faculties.
6. To prepare the byelaws towards the conferment of Honorary Degrees to the persons of eminence in recognition of their exemplary contribution.

The Academic Council approved and adopted the suggestions and recommendations of the Planning & Monitoring Board for its execution by evolving appropriate targeted action plan.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.7 :

To consider the report of the Deans Committee on revision in UG curriculum Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurvedic Sciences & Nursing Sciences and approved by the concerned BOS and Deans Committee.

The report of the Deans Committee on revision in UG curriculum Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurvedic Sciences & Nursing Sciences and recommended by the concerned BOS, upon incorporations of the suggestions made during the Departmental Presentation have been adopted and approved by the Academic Council for implementation from the current academic session 2015-16.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.8 :

To consider the amendments in the Ordinance No.32 of 2013 pertaining to the examinations leading to the PG Degree in the Faculty of Ayurvedic Sciences.

The amendments to the Ordinance No. 32 of 2013 pertaining to the examinations leading to the PG Degree in the Faculty of Ayurvedic Sciences were presented before the Academic Council. After detailed discussion, the Academic unanimously approved the same with retrospective effect for implementation.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.9 :

To consider the proposal of appointing two sets of examiners for the practical examinations under the Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry.

The proposal for appointing two sets of examiners for the practical examinations in the Faculty of Dentistry as in vogue in the Faculty of Medicine was not accepted by the Academic Council at this juncture since the intake for the BDS course is 100 only whereas intake of the Faculty of Medicine is 200.

Item No.10 :

To note the Compliance of last years Academic Calendar and Annual Calendar for various statutory and non statutory meetings including annual university examination i.e. 2014-15.

The Academic Council noted with satisfaction the compliance of last years Academic Calendar and Annual Calendar for various statutory and non statutory meetings including annual university examination i.e. 2014-15 which was significantly satisfactory. It further suggested that the deficiencies if any in adherence of calendar may be compensated with additional initiatives hereafter.

Item No.11 :

To consider the annual calendar for conduction of various activities i.e. CME., Conferences, Workshops etc. planned during the academic session 2015-16 and compliance of annual activities conducted during the last academic session 2014-15.

The Annual Calendar for the various activities of CMEs, Seminars, Conferences, Workshops planned for the academic session 2015-16 as notified were noted and approved by the Academic Council.

The compliance of annual activities planned vis-à-vis conducted during the last academic session 2014-15 was also noted and approved by the Academic Council. Hon. Chairman informed that the compliance to the schedule is significantly high and it has been reasonably well adhered to with greater involvement and the extent of achievement was substantially high. The Academic Council adopted the compliance

report and also appreciated the efforts taken by the Director, SHPE&R in monitoring the schedule effectively.

Item No.12 :

To consider the proposal of the Registrar for transferring M.Phil (Health Professionals Education) and MHA & M Courses under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Sciences.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the transfer of the Master of Hospital Administration & Management course under the Para Medical Health Sciences to the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health Sciences from the batch of students to be admitted during the ensuing academic Session 2015-16.

The Academic Council opined that the M.Phil (Health Professionals' Education) course shall continue to be under the Faculty of Medicine as in vogue, however, the certification would indicate the faculty of the awardee in bracket.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.13 :

To consider the yearly report of the Convener on 'Evaluation Reforms' in the university .

The yearly report of the Convener on 'Evaluation Reforms' in the university was placed before the Academic Council. After going through the report on evaluation reforms , the Academic Council observed that all most all the aspect on evaluation reforms have been incorporated in the report, the committee further suggested evaluation reforms for the year 2015-16.

The Academic Council adopted the report with satisfaction and further directed to include the indicators of evaluation reforms in the context of outcome analysis hereafter.

Item No.14 :

To consider the Annual Report of the Convener Academic Appraisal Programme on implementation, management and monitoring of the educational programme / courses in terms of governing guidelines and planning for the academic session 2014-15.

The Academic Appraisal Report for the academic session 2014-15 was presented before the Academic Council. It was informed by the Convener that the report was discussed at length in the Jt.College Council meeting and there were certain observations of the Jt. College Council which were incorporated in the Report.

The Academic Council adopted the report with the observations made at the Jt. College Council with satisfaction.

Item No.15 :

To consider the communications received from Medical Council of India pertaining to -

I) Rechristening of the 'Advance Course' as 'Fellowship in Medical Education' by the Medical Council of India

It was informed by the Registrar that the Medical Council of India has approved the proposal initiated by the Director, School for Health Professionals Education & Research, DMIMS (Deemed University) and pursued by the Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra, Chief Advisor in his capacity as the Chairman of the Academic Committee of the Medical Council of India towards re-naming the Advance Course launched by the Medical Council of India through its recognized Nodal Centres under the rubric of National Faculty Development Programme as 'Fellowship in Medical Education' The '**notable initiative**' Director SHPE&R and Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra has enabled the Medical Council of India to take up the onus of conferring '**Fellowship**' for the first time in its history ever since its inception way back in the year 1933 under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1933..

The Academic Council noted the letter and extended its gratitude and appreciations towards the initiatives taken by the Director, School of Health Profession and Research and its entire team under the guidance of Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra, Chief Advisor of the University.

II) Conferment of Honor and distinction to meritorious student of unfurling the National Flag on the occasion of Independence Day and Republic Day on rotational basis

It was further informed that the Medical Council of India vide circular letter dated 1.6.2015 addressed to all the Deans/Principal of the Medical Colleges in the country in respect of the meritorious students at the university examinations of the concerned medical colleges being conferred with the honor and distinction of unfurling the National Flag on the occasion of Independence Day and Republic Day on rotational basis. The said 'healthy practice' was incorporated for the 'first time' in **Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Nagpur**, under the initiative of the then Vice Chancellor of the University Dr. Vedprakash Mishra. The NAAC in its assessment report of the university where under the university was accorded 'A' Grade and had observed that the University is practicing a 'unique healthy practice' which is motivating for the students and is 'exemplary' in nature hence should be replicated by all the medical institutions in the country.

The circular dated 01.06.2015 from the Medical Council of India turns out to be an actualization of the said healthy practice being initiated under the guidance of Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra in all the medical colleges in the country. The Academic Council noted the circular of Medical Council of India with satisfaction.

Item No.16 :

To note the letter No. 4-5/2014-Uni dated 20.4.2015 alongwith the gazette notification from the Secretary CCIM regarding inclusion of B.A.M.S. degree in respect of MGAC under the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) in the second schedule of IMCC Act, 1970.

The Academic Council noted the letter No. 4-5/2014-Uni dated 20.4.2015 alongwith the gazette notification from the Secretary CCIM regarding inclusion of B.A.M.S. degree in respect of MGAC under the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) in the second schedule of IMCC Act, 1970.

Item No.17 :

To note and ratify the action taken by the Hon. Vice Chancellor on behalf of the Academic Council -

- i) **On the communication No. F.1-1/2014(TE) dated 18th May, 2015 received from Jt.Secretary UGC regarding recognition of credit marks for Academic Electives specified by the CBSE in university while admitting students.**
- ii) **Appointment of Dr. Tarulata N. Pandya, Ex-Prof. Dravyaguna Vigyan, Jamnagar as Adjunct Faculty for the Deptt.of Dravyaguna Vigyan**

The proposal for starting of new fellowship courses / PDCC alongwith its syllabus as recommended by the Board of Studies was placed before the Academic Council. The Academic Council approved the proposal for starting the following new fellowship/PDCC courses from the session 2015-16,

Item No.19 :

To consider the draft Byelaws for the conferment of Honorary Degrees

The Academic Council unanimously deferred the consideration of this item since the prescribed procedure as laid down in the central enactment. of UGC has not scrupulously followed in framing the byelaws.

Item No.20 :

To consider the points arising out of the meeting of the Jt. College Council meeting held on 11th July, 2015 :

The recommendations of the Jt. College Council were considered one by one.

1) Registration of Ph.D. students under those Ph.D. Supervisors who are already registered for Ph.D. in the same or other faculty.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the recommendation on the ground that the prescribed eligibility for recognition of Ph.D. Supervisor as in vogue in the university is 15 years of teaching experience with 8 years as recognized PG teacher. The university has recognized Ph.D. Supervisor not on the basis they possessing the Ph.D. qualification. Since the recognized Ph.D. supervisor registers for Ph.D. in the same or other faculty to upgrade his qualifications continues to be the Ph.D. Supervisor.

2) Designating every recognized Ph.D. Supervisor in the university as Visiting Professor.

The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the Jt.College Council towards designating every recognized Ph.D. Supervisor of the University who are not the full time Professor in the constituent units of the University as "Visiting Professor" of the University in token recognition of their research and academic contributions.

3) Creation of Ex-officio adjunct faculty for the purposes of strengthening research linkages.

The Academic council approved the recommendations as a policy towards creation of the Ex-officio Adjunct faculty for the purposes of strengthening research linkages in the university.

4) The policy document for addition of fourth P in the existing three Ps. i.e. Participation at PG Orientation, Poster, Presentation and publication for the purposes of quality up gradation.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the policy document for addition of fourth P in the existing three Ps. i.e. Participation at PG Orientation, Poster, Presentation and publication for the purposes of quality up gradation. It further resolved that upon approval from the Board of Management, the Policy document be forwarded to Medical Council of India for consideration which is worthy implementation as a national policy.

5) The policy document on patent and copy rights as recommended by the Jt. College Council.

The Academic Council approved the Process Calibration SOP for Application of Patents and Copy Rights documents for implementation and appropriate notification for information of all concerned.

6) Adoption of Need Analysis document as mother document for the purposes of need analysis on academic matters and functional units..

The policy pertaining to the "Need Analysis Policy of the University" on all academic matters has been approved by the Academic Council for its scrupulous adherence. The policy may be notified for information of all concerned through a notification.

7) Creation of separate Autonomous Medical Education Units in the Faculty of Dentistry, Faculty of Ayurvedic Science & Nursing sciences on lines of Deptt. of Medical Education of JNMC for Faculty Development programme of respective faculties which will be integral part of SHPE&R.

The Academic Council approved the recommendation towards creation of the Autonomous functional 'Education Units' at the Sharad Pawar Dental College, Mahatma Gandhi Ayurvedic College and Smt. Radhikabai Meghe Memorial College of Nursing respectively on the lines of the 'Medical Education Unit' at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College for undertaking the task of periodic update through structured and well laid Faculty Development programmes for the teaching faculty of respective constituent units, running Basic and Advance Course upon their formulation, generation, validation and standardization of learning resource material, Electronic Question Bank with Model Answers under the overall guidance of the Head of the Deptt. of Medical Education, Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College and Hon. Director, School for Health Professional Education & Ressearch from time to time. However, budgetary requirements for these autonomous education units be incorporated separately for consideration of the Finance Committee and thereafter Board of Management.

8) Amendment in governing Ordinance pertaining to registration of students with M.Sc. qualification for Ph.D.

The Academic Council approved the incorporation of amendment in the governing Ph.D. Ordinance towards inclusion of M.Sc. and M.Pharm qualification for the purposes broadening of interdisciplinary approach with retrospective effect. This will be applicable to the students who appeared and passed in the entrance examination conducted by the University in January & June, 2015.

9) Uniform Policy guidelines for Revision in PG Curriculum

The Academic Council unanimously approved the SOP/Guidelines for update of syllabi/curriculum for Post Graduate Courses in the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurvedic Sciences & Nursing Sciences in the university to be carried out during the current academic session 2015-16 to be effected from the academic session 2016-17

10) Implementing the system of formative assessment of PG students across the faculty.

The Academic Council approved the incorporation of system of formative assessment of PG students in the university across the faculty upon its approved by the Board of Management and their inclusion in the governing PG

Regulation/Ordinance for implementation from the next academic session i.e. 2016-17 as a statutory requirement.

11) Policy for avoiding last minute substitution during the university practical exam.

Academic Council notes with concern the last minutes substitutions during the university practical examination and directed the Board of Examinations to evolve necessary policy/guidelines in the matter as it deemed appropriate to avoid haphazard substitutions in future.

12) Implementation of ECE to Dental, Ayurvedic & Nursing Faculty on lines of ECE document of Faculty of Medicine.

It was informed that Item No.1 & 2 pertaining to the confirmation of the minutes of the Last meeting of the Academic Council held on 25th Feb. 2015 and the Action Report on the Actionable points arising out of the Minutes were confirmed in the meeting held on 29th June, 2015,. hence in continuation the following items as per the agenda were discussed :

Item No.3 :

To confirm the minutes of the last adjourned meeting of the Academic Council held on Monday, the 29th June, 2015.

The draft Minutes of the adjourned meeting of the Academic Council held on 29th June, 2015 was circulated to all the members requesting them to suggest modification(s) /correction(s) if any required. Since no corrections in the draft minutes were suggested by any of the members, the minutes of the meeting were read out and confirmed unanimously.

Item No.4 :

To Re-consider the recommendations of the Academic Council pertaining to Establishment of the University Department of Biotechnology under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health Sciences, with one full time faculty member so as to start a unique post graduate programme in Entrepreneurial Biotechnology a in phasic manner as referred by the Board of Management.

The Registrar informed that the recommendations of the Academic Council made in its meeting held on 25th Feb. 2015 pertaining to establishment of the **University Department of Biotechnology** under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health Sciences, with one full time faculty member so as to start a unique post graduate programme in **Entrepreneurial Biotechnology** in a phasic manner was placed before the Board of Management in its meeting held on 30th March, 2015 for the consideration. The Board of Management opined that Bio-Technology under the Faculty of interdisciplinary Health Sciences would not be a valid combination. Bio-technology is a stream by itself and without the permission of the UGC or Ministry of HRD, the University cannot start an independent Bio-technology Deptt. under its ambit. It further suggested that instead of establishing a University Deptt. of Bio-technology under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health sciences; a '**University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Medicine**' may be established and the matter was referred back to the Academic Council for re-consideration.

A background note towards establishment of University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Medicine in a phasic manner alongwith the financial prepositions as prepared by Dr. Sandeep Shrivastava, Dean, JNMC on the advice of the Board of Management was placed before the Academic Council for consideration.

The matter was discussed at length. The observations given by BoM were well received by the Academic Council and the proposal in the new format was appreciated by the Academic Council.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the observations of the Board of Management and the background note towards the establishment of the new deptt. appended thereto. It further suggested that the word 'Medicine' be replaced with 'Health Sciences' whereby the nomenclature shall be University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Health Sciences.

The Academic Council authorized Dr. Sandeep Shrivastava, Dean, JNMC to evolve the administrative, academic and financial feasibility of the entire plan including its phases for the consideration of the Finance Committee and Board of Management for consideration and approval.

It was further resolved that the first phase of establishment of the University Deptt. of Technological Interventions in Health Sciences must be completed by the end of the academic year 2017-18 i.e. end of five years Perspective Development Plan period 2012-13 – 2017-18.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.5 :

To consider the recommendation of the Board of Examinations made in its emergent meeting held on meeting held 4th April, 2015 –

- 1) Pertaining to addition of a fourth column to the effect 'accepted with corrections', so as to accommodate the modality, which is in operation but has not been indicated in the proforma.**
- 2) The forth column would also bring to fore the column pertaining to 'to be resubmitted after suggestion' would mean that the same would be required to be taken up for evaluation at the subsequent examination of the University.**
- 3) The incorporation of aforesaid guidelines in the governing the evaluation of thesis.**
- 4) The Special Examination Committee should be more vigilant in the dispensation of the required counts at their disposal by a greater degree of vigilance scrutiny blended with care and caution.**
- 5) The recommendations brought out by the Special Examination Committee on any such count should be looked into by the 'Standing Adhoc Committee' of the University in a time bound frame to be made known to all concerned.**

It was informed that in view of the casual taking of the concluding columns by the Internal Valuers and to tide over the situation as of now, the Board of Examination for the purposes of Academic up-gradations made the above recommendations.

The Academic Council unanimously adopted the recommendations of the Board of Examinations. It further directed that these recommendations may be blended with the thesis guidelines and thesis evaluation guidelines to be made known to all concerned right from the beginning and also made known to all concerned and also be included at the PGOOC every year.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.6 :

To note the recommendations of the Planning & Monitoring Board meeting held on 30th March, 2015

The suggestions and recommendations of the Planning & Monitoring Board meeting held on 30th March, 2015 were placed before the Academic Council. The Academic Council went through the suggestions and recommendations point wise. After discussion at length it was unanimously decided that –

1. The Centre for Health Sciences Education Policy & Planning, School for Health Professionals Education & Research and School of Advanced Studies which are the stand alone, functional units and not having the status of constituent unit be declared and notified as the Centre of Excellence initially.
2. To augment the percentage of total no. of interdisciplinary combinations introduced vis a vis total programme to the extent of 25%,
3. To issue guidelines for preparation of proceedings and outcome of international Conferences to ascertain the Quality Status of the International Conference.
4. The proposal for the establishment of a super speciality ancillary hospital by the parent trust which would be outside the purview of the university/teaching hospital and the corpus generated thereof should be utilized as compensatory revenue towards the long term cost sustainability/ developmental pursuits of the teaching hospital/university was accepted in principle. The super speciality connotation in the existing teaching hospital shall be over and above in the appropriate time
5. To set up multiple satellite linkages for education/telemedicine services, health professionals education and capacity building, Interaction/sharing of information from medical colleges towards short term training, specialized lectures from renowned medical college/faculties.
6. To prepare the byelaws towards the conferment of Honorary Degrees to the persons of eminence in recognition of their exemplary contribution.

The Academic Council approved and adopted the suggestions and recommendations of the Planning & Monitoring Board for its execution by evolving appropriate targeted action plan.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.7 :

To consider the report of the Deans Committee on revision in UG curriculum Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurvedic Sciences & Nursing Sciences and approved by the concerned BOS and Deans Committee.

The report of the Deans Committee on revision in UG curriculum Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurvedic Sciences & Nursing Sciences and recommended by the concerned BOS, upon incorporations of the suggestions made during the Departmental Presentation have been adopted and approved by the Academic Council for implementation from the current academic session 2015-16.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.8 :

To consider the amendments in the Ordinance No.32 of 2013 pertaining to the examinations leading to the PG Degree in the Faculty of Ayurvedic Sciences.

The amendments to the Ordinance No. 32 of 2013 pertaining to the examinations leading to the PG Degree in the Faculty of Ayurvedic Sciences were presented before the Academic Council. After detailed discussion, the Academic unanimously approved the same with retrospective effect for implementation.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.9 :

To consider the proposal of appointing two sets of examiners for the practical examinations under the Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry.

The proposal for appointing two sets of examiners for the practical examinations in the Faculty of Dentistry as in vogue in the Faculty of Medicine was not accepted by the Academic Council at this juncture since the intake for the BDS course is 100 only whereas intake of the Faculty of Medicine is 200.

Item No.10 :

To note the Compliance of last years Academic Calendar and Annual Calendar for various statutory and non statutory meetings including annual university examination i.e. 2014-15.

The Academic Council noted with satisfaction the compliance of last years Academic Calendar and Annual Calendar for various statutory and non statutory meetings including annual university examination i.e. 2014-15 which was significantly satisfactory. It further suggested that the deficiencies if any in adherence of calendar may be compensated with additional initiatives hereafter.

Item No.11 :

To consider the annual calendar for conduction of various activities i.e. CME., Conferences, Workshops etc. planned during the academic session 2015-16 and compliance of annual activities conducted during the last academic session 2014-15.

The Annual Calendar for the various activities of CMEs, Seminars, Conferences, Workshops planned for the academic session 2015-16 as notified were noted and approved by the Academic Council.

The compliance of annual activities planned vis-à-vis conducted during the last academic session 2014-15 was also noted and approved by the Academic Council. Hon. Chairman informed that the compliance to the schedule is significantly high and it has been reasonably well adhered to with greater involvement and the extent of achievement was substantially high. The Academic Council adopted the compliance

report and also appreciated the efforts taken by the Director, SHPE&R in monitoring the schedule effectively.

Item No.12 :

To consider the proposal of the Registrar for transferring M.Phil (Health Professionals Education) and MHA & M Courses under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Sciences.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the transfer of the Master of Hospital Administration & Management course under the Para Medical Health Sciences to the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Health Sciences from the batch of students to be admitted during the ensuing academic Session 2015-16.

The Academic Council opined that the M.Phil (Health Professionals' Education) course shall continue to be under the Faculty of Medicine as in vogue, however, the certification would indicate the faculty of the awardee in bracket.

The minutes of this particular item were read out in the meeting and confirmed for initiating immediate action in the matter.

Item No.13 :

To consider the yearly report of the Convener on 'Evaluation Reforms' in the university .

The yearly report of the Convener on 'Evaluation Reforms' in the university was placed before the Academic Council. After going through the report on evaluation reforms , the Academic Council observed that all most all the aspect on evaluation reforms have been incorporated in the report, the committee further suggested evaluation reforms for the year 2015-16.

The Academic Council adopted the report with satisfaction and further directed to include the indicators of evaluation reforms in the context of outcome analysis hereafter.

Item No.14 :

To consider the Annual Report of the Convener Academic Appraisal Programme on implementation, management and monitoring of the educational programme / courses in terms of governing guidelines and planning for the academic session 2014-15.

The Academic Appraisal Report for the academic session 2014-15 was presented before the Academic Council. It was informed by the Convener that the report was discussed at length in the Jt.College Council meeting and there were certain observations of the Jt. College Council which were incorporated in the Report.

The Academic Council adopted the report with the observations made at the Jt. College Council with satisfaction.

Item No.15 :

To consider the communications received from Medical Council of India pertaining to -

I) Rechristening of the 'Advance Course' as 'Fellowship in Medical Education' by the Medical Council of India

It was informed by the Registrar that the Medical Council of India has approved the proposal initiated by the Director, School for Health Professionals Education & Research, DMIMS (Deemed University) and pursued by the Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra, Chief Advisor in his capacity as the Chairman of the Academic Committee of the Medical Council of India towards re-naming the Advance Course launched by the Medical Council of India through its recognized Nodal Centres under the rubric of National Faculty Development Programme as 'Fellowship in Medical Education' The '**notable initiative**' Director SHPE&R and Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra has enabled the Medical Council of India to take up the onus of conferring '**Fellowship**' for the first time in its history ever since its inception way back in the year 1933 under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1933..

The Academic Council noted the letter and extended its gratitude and appreciations towards the initiatives taken by the Director, School of Health Profession and Research and its entire team under the guidance of Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra, Chief Advisor of the University.

II) Conferment of Honor and distinction to meritorious student of unfurling the National Flag on the occasion of Independence Day and Republic Day on rotational basis

It was further informed that the Medical Council of India vide circular letter dated 1.6.2015 addressed to all the Deans/Principal of the Medical Colleges in the country in respect of the meritorious students at the university examinations of the concerned medical colleges being conferred with the honor and distinction of unfurling the National Flag on the occasion of Independence Day and Republic Day on rotational basis. The said 'healthy practice' was incorporated for the 'first time' in **Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Nagpur**, under the initiative of the then Vice Chancellor of the University Dr. Vedprakash Mishra. The NAAC in its assessment report of the university where under the university was accorded 'A' Grade and had observed that the University is practicing a 'unique healthy practice' which is motivating for the students and is 'exemplary' in nature hence should be replicated by all the medical institutions in the country.

The circular dated 01.06.2015 from the Medical Council of India turns out to be an actualization of the said healthy practice being initiated under the guidance of Hon. Dr. Vedprakash Mishra in all the medical colleges in the country. The Academic Council noted the circular of Medical Council of India with satisfaction.

Item No.16 :

To note the letter No. 4-5/2014-Uni dated 20.4.2015 alongwith the gazette notification from the Secretary CCIM regarding inclusion of B.A.M.S. degree in respect of MGAC under the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) in the second schedule of IMCC Act, 1970.

The Academic Council noted the letter No. 4-5/2014-Uni dated 20.4.2015 alongwith the gazette notification from the Secretary CCIM regarding inclusion of B.A.M.S. degree in respect of MGAC under the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) in the second schedule of IMCC Act, 1970.

Item No.17 :

To note and ratify the action taken by the Hon. Vice Chancellor on behalf of the Academic Council -

- i) **On the communication No. F.1-1/2014(TE) dated 18th May, 2015 received from Jt.Secretary UGC regarding recognition of credit marks for Academic Electives specified by the CBSE in university while admitting students.**
- ii) **Appointment of Dr. Tarulata N. Pandya, Ex-Prof. Dravyaguna Vigyan, Jamnagar as Adjunct Faculty for the Deptt.of Dravyaguna Vigyan**

The proposal for starting of new fellowship courses / PDCC alongwith its syllabus as recommended by the Board of Studies was placed before the Academic Council. The Academic Council approved the proposal for starting the following new fellowship/PDCC courses from the session 2015-16,

Item No.19 :

To consider the draft Byelaws for the conferment of Honorary Degrees

The Academic Council unanimously deferred the consideration of this item since the prescribed procedure as laid down in the central enactment. of UGC has not scrupulously followed in framing the byelaws.

Item No.20 :

To consider the points arising out of the meeting of the Jt. College Council meeting held on 11th July, 2015 :

The recommendations of the Jt. College Council were considered one by one.

1) Registration of Ph.D. students under those Ph.D. Supervisors who are already registered for Ph.D. in the same or other faculty.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the recommendation on the ground that the prescribed eligibility for recognition of Ph.D. Supervisor as in vogue in the university is 15 years of teaching experience with 8 years as recognized PG teacher. The university has recognized Ph.D. Supervisor not on the basis they possessing the Ph.D. qualification. Since the recognized Ph.D. supervisor registers for Ph.D. in the same or other faculty to upgrade his qualifications continues to be the Ph.D. Supervisor.

2) Designating every recognized Ph.D. Supervisor in the university as Visiting Professor.

The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the Jt.College Council towards designating every recognized Ph.D. Supervisor of the University who are not the full time Professor in the constituent units of the University as "Visiting Professor" of the University in token recognition of their research and academic contributions.

3) Creation of Ex-officio adjunct faculty for the purposes of strengthening research linkages.

The Academic council approved the recommendations as a policy towards creation of the Ex-officio Adjunct faculty for the purposes of strengthening research linkages in the university.

4) The policy document for addition of fourth P in the existing three Ps. i.e. Participation at PG Orientation, Poster, Presentation and publication for the purposes of quality up gradation.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the policy document for addition of fourth P in the existing three Ps. i.e. Participation at PG Orientation, Poster, Presentation and publication for the purposes of quality up gradation. It further resolved that upon approval from the Board of Management, the Policy document be forwarded to Medical Council of India for consideration which is worthy implementation as a national policy.

5) The policy document on patent and copy rights as recommended by the Jt. College Council.

The Academic Council approved the Process Calibration SOP for Application of Patents and Copy Rights documents for implementation and appropriate notification for information of all concerned.

6) Adoption of Need Analysis document as mother document for the purposes of need analysis on academic matters and functional units..

The policy pertaining to the "Need Analysis Policy of the University" on all academic matters has been approved by the Academic Council for its scrupulous adherence. The policy may be notified for information of all concerned through a notification.

7) Creation of separate Autonomous Medical Education Units in the Faculty of Dentistry, Faculty of Ayurvedic Science & Nursing sciences on lines of Deptt. of Medical Education of JNMC for Faculty Development programme of respective faculties which will be integral part of SHPE&R.

The Academic Council approved the recommendation towards creation of the Autonomous functional 'Education Units' at the Sharad Pawar Dental College, Mahatma Gandhi Ayurvedic College and Smt. Radhikabai Meghe Memorial College of Nursing respectively on the lines of the 'Medical Education Unit' at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College for undertaking the task of periodic update through structured and well laid Faculty Development programmes for the teaching faculty of respective constituent units, running Basic and Advance Course upon their formulation, generation, validation and standardization of learning resource material, Electronic Question Bank with Model Answers under the overall guidance of the Head of the Deptt. of Medical Education, Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College and Hon. Director, School for Health Professional Education & Ressearch from time to time. However, budgetary requirements for these autonomous education units be incorporated separately for consideration of the Finance Committee and thereafter Board of Management.

8) Amendment in governing Ordinance pertaining to registration of students with M.Sc. qualification for Ph.D.

The Academic Council approved the incorporation of amendment in the governing Ph.D. Ordinance towards inclusion of M.Sc. and M.Pharm qualification for the purposes broadening of interdisciplinary approach with retrospective effect. This will be applicable to the students who appeared and passed in the entrance examination conducted by the University in January & June, 2015.

9) Uniform Policy guidelines for Revision in PG Curriculum

The Academic Council unanimously approved the SOP/Guidelines for update of syllabi/curriculum for Post Graduate Courses in the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurvedic Sciences & Nursing Sciences in the university to be carried out during the current academic session 2015-16 to be effected from the academic session 2016-17

10) Implementing the system of formative assessment of PG students across the faculty.

The Academic Council approved the incorporation of system of formative assessment of PG students in the university across the faculty upon its approved by the Board of Management and their inclusion in the governing PG

Regulation/Ordinance for implementation from the next academic session i.e. 2016-17 as a statutory requirement.

11) Policy for avoiding last minute substitution during the university practical exam.

Academic Council notes with concern the last minutes substitutions during the university practical examination and directed the Board of Examinations to evolve necessary policy/guidelines in the matter as it deemed appropriate to avoid haphazard substitutions in future.

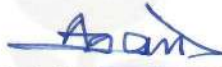
